1. Regular Board Meeting Call to Order

The November 10, 2016 meeting of the Board of Directors of the Southeast Chapter of the Michigan Society of Professional Surveyors was called to order at 5:45 PM by President Scott Roth PS. 7. Committees Reports

Mike Peniewski Presentation on Survey Certificate Program – Adolfo Castillo PS reported that Mike has requested time to speak with the Board or Membership regarding a program from the University of Toledo which will provide certificates of completion for courses in surveying, which may lead a person to being approved to write the surveyors exam.
